



### **A Background to our School Self- Evaluation:**

Sutton Park School has been working diligently to improve the educational experience of its students, with a focus on addressing specific areas that require attention. The process of School Self Evaluation (SSE) with a focus on digital learning in Sutton Park School commenced in February 2020 due to the Covid 19 pandemic. During Covid 19 Sutton Park School successfully implemented online learning throughout both lockdowns in March 2020 and January 2021. In 2020/2021 our SSE focus was to create a vision for our digital strategy and the implementation of Lenovo for 1<sup>st</sup> year, bring your own device for 2<sup>nd</sup>- 6<sup>th</sup> year and introduce surface pro devices for staff. In September 2022, 1<sup>st</sup>-2<sup>nd</sup> years are equipped with Lenovo devices with the remaining years bringing their own device.

### **Our Focus for School Self- Evaluation 2022-2023:**

In the academic year 2022/2023, we focused on enhancing our digital vision by using the domains, standards, and statements from the “Digital Learning Framework for Post Primary Schools” to create 8 targets for our School Improvement Plan 2022-2023.
