Competition Rules

- Candidates play <u>one piece</u> or movement of their own choice not exceeding five minutes duration.
- 2. Please note 'under 10' means 'aged 10 and under'. (The same applies in all categories)
- 3 Candidates must qualify in age on 27th April 2024
- 4 An original copy of the music must be provided for the adjudicator on the day of competition.
- 5 Candidates must register in the office thirty minutes before their competition is due to begin.
- 6 The <u>closing date</u> for receipt of music entries is Tuesday 9th April
- 7 The decision of the adjudicator is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 8 Previous first prize winners may not compete in the same category again.
- 9 Accompanist can only be provided if a clear <u>hard copy</u> of the music comes in with the entry. Digital transfer not accepted.
- *Beginners are classed as those who have only been learning their instrument for a short time, a year or two.

 Any instrument or voice in the group is accepted
